Council discussed the 28E Agreement to form a Solid Waste Commission in the county for the operation of the landfill. There was concern about the proposal of having Belle Plaine and Vinton each having one member on the Executive Committee, leaving only two members to represent the rest of the towns in the county. Mayor Becker will attend the meeting on February 20<sup>th</sup> at 6 PM at Vinton. On motion by Korsmo, second by Herman, council voted to authorize the Mayor to sign the 28E Agreement providing we have a member on the Executive Committee. Aye: Herman, Drahos, Duball and Korsmo. Nay: none. Absent: Harbach. Motion carried.

Council discussed vehicles parked on the streets during snow removal. City Ordinance Chapter 69 Section 10 reads: SNOW REMOVAL. No person shall park, abandon or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley or City owned off street parking area during snow removal operations unless the snow has been removed or plowed from said street, alley or parking area and the snow has creased to fall. Please do not park on the designated area or you could be ticketed.

On motion by, Duball, second by Drahos, council voted to adjourn. Ayes: Herman, Drahos, Duball and Korsmo. Nays: none. Absent: Harbach. Motion carried. The next regular council meeting will be on Monday, March 3, 2014 at City Hall, 480 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, starting at 7:30 PM.
