The council opened the discussion about the Early Beginnings Daycare. Stark and Hepker updated the council on some of the things their attorneys are working on. Once these are completed then the grading can be done on the easement behind the daycare. The City Clerk will also work with the attorneys to ensure these items get completed in a timely fashion.

A presentation was given to the council by Karee Dietrich. The presentation was about adding a garden at Atkins Elementary School. The garden would be used to teach the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade kids about healthy eating. The Harbach made a motion to support the idea and concept of the garden, and to add this topic to the next agenda. The motion was seconded by Korsmo. Ayes: Harbach, Herman, Bishop and Korsmo. Nay: None. Motion carried.

The council opened discussion for other business. A discussion was brought up about the city election. Benton County changed the election results from unofficial to official on Friday the 13<sup>th</sup>. On the same day the city clerk received a letter with the election results. There was some concern over the elected council members not being contacted by the county. The new city council will be Dave Becker (Mayor), Kevin Korsmo, Tim Harbach, Diane Herman, Nathan Shepard and Rodney Haerther.

Bishop brought up some concerns about the library and the library budget. This will be added to the agenda for next council meeting. Some questions were brought up about snow removal along the sidewalks. The sidewalk running along Parkridge by the soccer fields was difficult to maintain. The snowmobile routes were changed to help address this. This is a difficult part to maintain because of the drifting snow.
