

 - 3 Full Time Public Works Employees
 - 2 Part Time Public Works Employees
 - 1 Full Time City Administrator
 - 1 Full Time City Clerk
 - 1 Part Time Deputy Clerk
 - 1 Temporary as needed Office Assistant
 - 1 Part Time Library Director
 - 3 Part Time Librarians

Sheriff's Contract:

•Notice of Proposed rate increase received. Maintaining budget at \$80K

Library:

- Programs \$3000 Summer reading / \$1500 Children & Adult Programs
- Wages/Benefits: Increase \$36,105
- •Technology: Increase \$4500 IT Expenses to be posted to Library vs City Hall
- •Books: Increase \$800
- Replace public computers \$4000

Sewer:

- Cleaning & Televising mains \$20K
- •Cleaning Lift Station Basin Annually \$5K

Budget Overview:

Parks:

- Building Repair and Maintenance & Capital Expense: Increase \$21,000
 - Park Pavilion: Bathroom repairs/new fixtures, replace door, Floor Epoxy & crack, Replace cabinets and Sink
 - Soccer Pavilion: Replace Kitchen Door
 - City Park: Resurface Basketball court, rebuild basketball hoops, rework ball diamond, patio for picnic tables, park benches, permanent trash cans, dog stations.
- Wages/Benefits: Increase \$28,900 for additional time for park improvements

Budget Overview

Water:

- Bldg Repair Maintenance \$29K
- Generator Switch \$7,500
- Capital Expense: \$340K
- tower \$155K/scada\$50K/scrubber 60K /Well#2 technology \$30K/ Software& Meters \$15K/Replace Heaters \$30K

Roads:

- 100K road maintenance: Panel replacement/Chip Seal/crack sealing
- Excavator and skid loader lease \$34K
- Trailer Equipment \$22K

Water System

- Process
 - Approximately 36+ million gallons of water a year
 - Averaging 3,000,000 gallons per month
- Testing and monitoring
 - Daily Testing and Monitor
 - Monthly / Quarterly / Annual testing and reporting
 - On call 24/7
- Maintain 15 Miles of Water Lines



Sewer System

- Process
 - Over 36+ million gallons of wastewater a year
 - Daily monitoring 365 days a year
 - Weekly Testing
 - Monthly reporting
 - On call 24/7
 - Maintain 20 Miles of Sewer Line
- Clean and Televise 1/5 of Mains



Garbage System

- Manage 750+ Garbage Accounts
 - 4 garbage rates 4 combinations of trash/recycle containers
 - Coordinate and monitor repair requests with Waste Management
 - Coordinate requests for container changes with Waste Management
 - Auditing All properties: verify billing matches containers on site
- Spring and Fall Clean Up

Park System:

- Maintain and mow 22 Acres of Park
 - City mows every week: April, May, June, September.
 - City mows as needed: July, August, and October
- Maintain all Playground Equipment
- •Inspect Playgrounds daily through season and weekly off season



Road System:

- City has 13 Miles of Streets
 - Plowing all streets equals 26 miles
 - City Plows on average 10 times a year = 260 miles of plowing
 - Annual street maintenance \$85K 100K per year
 - Crack Sealing, Chip Sealing, and panel replacement

Water / Sewer / Garbage Utility Billing

- Manage over 750 accounts:
 - Monthly billing / monthly late notices / shut off notices / monitor meters
 - Track and Manage several payment agreements
- Updating Meter Reading System
 - 2021 City Council approved updating meter reading system
 - Update is required due to FCC standards requirement changes
- Installation of new reading system:
 - Installation of communication system to water tower / tablets
 - Coordinating new system with old meters
 - •Setting Utility Billing System to receive meter readings from old and new meters

Water / Sewer / Garbage Utility Billing

- Updating billing system: Required to communicate with new meter technology required by FCC
 - Online billing system
 - Bills to be viewed online
 - Usage history and bill history remains online for 12+ months
 - Alerts sent when account is updated (new billing/ reminders/payments)
 - Email alerts e.g., snow emergency/water line break
 - Updating Online Payment System
 - Citizens will be able to pay through online billing system
 - Account holders can set account to auto pay on day of their choice
 - Online Payments will download and post directly to accounts
 - PCI Compliant
