Motion carried.

Stoltzfus moved to approve Resolution 964 a resolution setting the date for public hearing and additional action on proposal to enter into General Obligation Urban Renewal Loan Agreement and to borrow money thereunder. Koehn seconded. Ayes: Bell, Koehn, Petersen, Stoltzfus. Motion carried.

Stoltzfus moved to approve Resolution 965 a resolution approving pay request 3 in the amount of \$98,045 to Boomerang Corporation of Anamosa, Iowa. Koehn seconded. Ayes: Bell, Koehn, Petersen, Stoltzfus. Motion carried. Project removed 124 trees, trimmed 5, and ground over 4,000 inches of tree stumps.
