GOLF CART SAFETY ON ATKINS CITY STREETS

- ◆ City of Atkins Golf Cart owners must abide by both State of Iowa and City of Atkins laws.
- ◆ **Failure to obey these laws may result in traffic violations, as well as civil penalties up to \$750 for the first offense, and up to \$1,000 for repeat offenses.**
- ◆ Golf carts must be registered through City Hall to use on city streets. Registered Golf Carts will receive a City issued sticker to be placed on your golf cart for registration verification.
- ◆ All drivers must have a valid drivers license and be sixteen (16) years of age.
- ◆ You must carry proof of insurance.
- ◆ Golf Carts must have a slow moving vehicle sign and a bicycle safety flag.
- ◆ Golf cart must be equipped with adequate brakes.
- ◆ Golf carts shall not operate on Parkridge Road, 33rd Avenue, sidewalk, or a city street that is a primary road extension through the city.
- ◆ Golf Carts are only allowed to cross Parkridge Road, 33rd Ave. or a primary road extension. You may not drive on these roads.
- ◆ Hours of operation are sunrise to sunset.
- ◆ All Terrain Vehicles (ATVs) and Off Road Utility Vehicles (UTVs) are not permitted on any of the City of Atkins streets.
- ◆ You may not operate a golf cart in a careless, reckless, or negligent manner as to endanger any person or property of another.
- ◆ You may not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol while operating a golf cart.
